Project objective:

The project aims to increase the attractiveness and visits to the Danube border region by creating an attractive and competitive European destination with its own "Danube inland delta" brand, while preserving the natural and cultural heritage of the area.



Danube Inland Delta Small & Moson Danube

Partners: 9 partners (5 regions: BSK, TTSK, NSK a Gyor-Moson-Sopron a Komárom-Esztergom)

Budget: almost 3 mil. €

Main activities:

- Building cycle trails along the Small Danube;
- Building local points with ecotourism infrastructure:
 - 29 pontoons, 2 recreational water areas, 2 reconstructed watermills, 1
 water ecotourism youth center
- Creating a water track for boat tourists
- Creating joint cross-border destination "Danube inland delta" new brand
- Promotion activities
 - study tours, workshops, public events, school competitions etc.
